<b>Park</b> Evidence of antisocial behaviour	<p>In the morning, a member of staff will inspect the park for evidence of antisocial behaviour, including but not limited to: drug paraphernalia, broken glass, evidence of alcohol consumption.</p> <p>The sandpit will be checked for evidence of animal faeces.</p> <p>If any evidence is found, the park/sand pit will not be used during the session.</p> <p>If later in the day, when the park is being used, any evidence is found, then the CYP will be taken back inside immediately.</p>	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>Minimal</b>	<b>No</b>
<b>Park</b> Slips, trips and falls	<p>Staff to remind CYP of the risks involved when running outside, especially on uneven ground.</p> <p>A first aid kit will be taken over to the park.</p> <p>The session leader will ensure that an adequate number of staff with first aid training go to the park as well as remain in the hall.</p>	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>Minimal</b>	<b>No</b>
<b>BMX track</b> Uneven surfaces Members of the public using the BMX track with bikes	<p>If any members of the public are using the BMX track on bikes, CYP will not be allowed to access that area.</p>	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>Minimal</b>	<b>No</b>

	If the track is not being used, CYP will be allowed to play on it with a reminder to take care on uneven surfaces.				
<b>Zip Wire</b> Falls	CYP will be able to access the zip wire independently if they are deemed to understand the importance of holding on and can do so independently and safely.  CYP who pose a risk of letting go of the zip wire can access it with staff support. This support will always include at a minimum staying next to the CYP, with a hand supporting them.	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>Minimal</b>	<b>No</b>
<b>Sandpit</b> Sand being thrown, especially in eyes.	CYP will be reminded to not throw sand before being allowed into the sand pit.  If sand is thrown: the first time they will receive a verbal warning. If the behaviour occurs again, they will be taken away from the sand and explained why this has happened. They may be allowed to play in the sand again later, again with warning of sand being thrown.	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>Minimal</b>	<b>No</b>
<b>Pull-up bars</b> Falls	CYP will only be allowed to access these pieces of equipment if they are able to do so independently and have the strength to do so.	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>Minimal</b>	<b>No</b>
<b>Swinging, rotating seats</b> Falls	CYP will be reminded to hold on to the equipment when using it.  CYP will only be allowed to be fully swung if they are able to, and deemed to understand the	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>Minimal</b>	<b>No</b>

	<p>importance of, holding onto the equipment at all times.</p> <p>CYP will be allowed to use the equipment at a low height if they pose a risk of letting go of the equipment. A member of staff will stay close by to ensure they don't fall off.</p>
